Waste Dues

Port Esbjerg does not charge any fee for the collection of normal ship waste. However, the Port will charge a special fee in the following cases:

- The quantity of waste exceeds the quantity of waste that the vessel would under normal circumstances have produced since the vessel last called a port calculated as maximum BHP in 1,000 x sailing hours x 1/200 m3.
- The vessel wants to deliver waste outside normal working hours.
- Waste is disposed in the wrong containers or placed on the quays without prior notice.
- Waste oils contain less than 65 per cent oil or contain substances other than oil and water.
- Any unforeseen costs associated with waste disposal will be charged to the vessel. This applies for costs connected to delays (no matter the reason), no-shows or, for example, if the wastewater has a lower pump speed than anticipated.
